CERTIFICATION OF SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ACADEMIC PROGRAMS

- If the student is missing any doses of the hepatitis vaccine at the time of admission, the student will be responsible for going to a vaccination center, to be given the doses on the corresponding date.
- For those students enrolling in any of the academic programs which are related to the Health and Education fields among others, the internships/practicums centers and the Review Boards may require a negative criminal background record certification and Certification under Law 300 of September 2, 1999, better known as "Criminal Record Verification Act of Care Service Providers for the Children and the Elderly of Puerto Rico". The students may be required to submit vaccines certifications for specific shots, as well as other official documents or special requirements to begin the internship, take the licensing exams or during the years they are studying and before graduating from NUC.
- For the Criminal Justice, Pharmacy Technician and Nursing programs students should be 18 years of age or older in order to begin their internship/practice at the cooperating agencies. Also, some other academic programs may also require the age minimum previously mentioned in order for students to begin their internship.
