# BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION WITH MAJOR IN ACCOUNTING

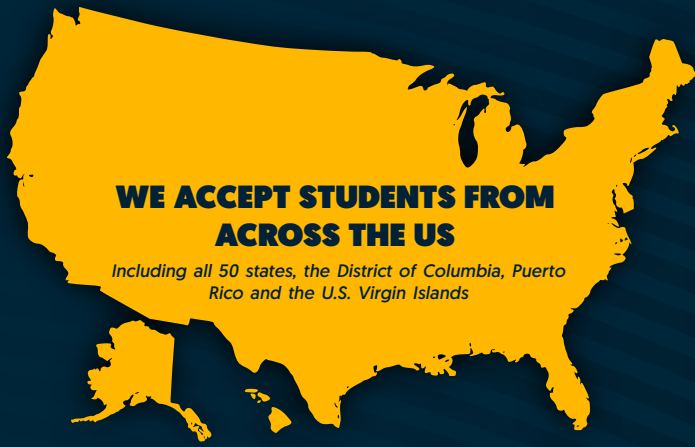
